Decorating the border is optional.

Please write your name and age (on 1st September 2018) **on the back** of your entry.

The handwriting classes are in the Children aged 6 to 10, and Children aged 11 to 15 sections.

LEMON DRIZZLE CAKE (Classes 89)

Ingredients

225g unsalted butter, softened
225g caster sugar
4 eggs
Finely grated zest 1 lemon
225g self-raising flour

For the drizzle topping

Juice 1½ lemons
85g caster sugar

Method

1. Heat oven to 180°C/fan 160°C/gas 4. Beat together 225g softened unsalted butter and 225g caster sugar until pale and creamy, then add 4 eggs, one at a time, slowly mixing through. Sift in 225g flour, then add the finely grated zest of 1 lemon and mix until well combined. Line a loaf tin (8 x 21cm) with greaseproof paper, then spoon in the mixture and level the top with a spoon.
2. Bake for 45-50 mins until a thin skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean. While the cake is cooling in its tin, mix together the juice of 1 1/2 lemons and 85g caster sugar to make the drizzle. Prick the warm cake all over with a skewer or fork, then pour over the drizzle – the juice will sink in and the sugar will form a lovely, crisp topping. Leave in the tin until completely cool, then remove cake from the tin.
